First week: Getting ready for Jesus

Scripture: Matthew 25: 1 - 13

As Jesus' bride, our attitude must be like the five wise virgins, not the five foolish ones! Although there was a delay by the bridegroom in this parable, this does not excuse the total lack of preparation for the bridegroom's coming. Nor should the delay cause the bride of Christ to develop a cavalier attitude. In addition, it is quite plausible for the church to be found sleeping instead of being active in Kingdom work. To avoid this spiritual malaise, the church should be fully prepared for the imminent return of the Lord to this earth.

- Pray that the bride of Christ will make advanced preparations for the return of the heavenly bridegroom.
- Pray that God's people will live a holy and blameless life in this world (2 Peter 3:14).
- For an urgent concern for evangelism and missions due to the imminence of the second coming.

Second week: Stay STRONG in times of trouble

Scripture: Acts 16: 25-26

How did Paul and Silas react when they were thrown into prison? They prayed, worshipped and brought God's presence into prison! Although the rulers of their time put them behind bars, they knew that God had the higher authority.

- Let's agree out loud that God has authority over your life, your church, our nation, and all the nations of the earth.
- Pray that when trouble comes, the Malaysian church will do what Paul and Silas did pray and worship and bring God's presence into our nation.
- Ask the Father to help align your heart with His for revival in this nation, and how you can recognise
 it and be a part of it.

Third week: Fighting in God's Kingdom

Scripture: Ephesians 6: 10-13

When we fight in God's Kingdom, we are not fighting what we see in the physical world but in the spiritual. This is why we need to stand strong in God's power because it is HIS power that will win us our battles. If the Malaysian Church wants to gain victories over the problems we see, we must first gain victories in the spiritual world. Let us stand strong in God and pray that HIS KINGDOM will reign in Malaysia.

• Pray for the Malaysian Christians to be steadfast, tenacious and committed citizens of the Kingdom of God who will stand for their faith against any onslaught.



 Let us uphold our country in prayer continuously. Let us put on the full armour of God and be ready for battle.



Fourth week: Salt of the earth

Scripture: Matthews 5:13

As disciples of Jesus, we have the properties and effects of salt. We impact the nation with our being. Our beliefs, values and passions as reflected in our choices, speech, actions and lifestyles should influence our society – disinfecting it from elements that corrupt or destroy while preserving its integrity.

- Pray that disciples of Jesus will not compromise and be willing to set apart, live by God's standards, and be an example of integrity where we are.
- Pray that Christians will be engaged in social issues, speaking out boldly yet wisely against injustice in love and humility.
- Pray for more Christians to join the government and education sectors where our presence is lacking.
